All art will be picked up after the reception on Sunday, April 19th.

CATEGORIES: BY GRADE LEVEL (1st - 3rd) (4th - 6th) (7th - 9th) (10th - 12th)

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ART:

- Entries from grades 1 - 6 will be mounted on black construction paper to hang at the show.
- Size: Elementary School Paintings or Photographs no larger than 11 in. x17 in.
- If not mounted RFA will furnish Black Construction Paper or mount art on paper after received.
- All entries should have a label on the back with artist's name, school, teacher and grade.
- Sculpture, Clay, Glass, etc., will be displayed on tables.

MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL ART:

- Hanging entry pieces from grades 7-12 should be matted or framed.
- RFA has approximately 35 easels for large pieces and panels for smaller hanging art.
- All entries should have a label on the back with artist's name, school, teacher and grade.
- Sculpture, Clay, Glass, etc., will be displayed on tables or on floor.
- Size restriction: Must fit through doorway.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

- Show is open to all Placer County students in 1st - 12th grades.
- Students do not have to be enrolled in a Placer County school. They may be home schooled, in private schools, or taking art classes.
- Students may enter one piece of artwork. Artwork, sculpture, clay, photography, glass work, beading, leather work will be accepted.
- Each entry will receive a participation ribbon.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place ribbons will be awarded, and certificates given in each category at the awards reception.
- All entries should have a label on the back with artist's name, school, teacher and grade.
